



APPRENTICESHIP FUNDING EXPLAINED



KICK START YOUR TRAINING SCHEMES WITH GOVERNMENT FUNDING

Funding is available directly from the Government or through your apprenticeship levy. Funds can be accessed through your Digital Apprenticeship Service (DAS) Account.

Small to medium sized enterprise
(fewer than 50 employees)

Apprentices aged 16-18:
The Government will pay 100% of the training costs.

Apprentices aged 19+:
You pay 5% towards the cost and the Government pays 95%.

Small to medium sized enterprises
(more than 50 employees)

Apprentices aged 16+:
You pay 5% towards the cost and the Government pays 95%.

Large employers
(annual wage bill over £3 million)

You can pay for the apprentice you want using your apprenticeship levy contribution.

Levy Transfers

As a levy paying employer, you can transfer up to 25% of your unused levy funds to a business of your choice to fund their apprenticeship training opportunities.
